Information

In addition to the prohibited practice of plagiarism, students are also not allowed to use AI (artificial intelligence) resources – such as ChatGPT – in their academic work, including dissertations.

PUST Faculty of Theology Anti-Plagiarism Policy

The Dean's Office will check the dissertation proposal for plagiarism and the use of artificial intelligence, using the software currently approved by the university. If any significant part of a document submitted is found to be plagiarized or produced by artificial intelligence, the entire dissertation proposal will be rejected, with no possibility to submit another proposal in the same faculty. (A significant part of a dissertation proposal is more than three sentences.)
