BIO - fr. Loïc-Marie Le Bot, O.P.

Fr. Loïc-Marie Le Bot was born in 1969. After studying public law at the University of Bordeaux, he entered the Province of Toulouse in 1994. He studied philosophy and theology at the Studium of Toulouse (1995-2001). After his ordination to the priesthood, he was sent to the Angelicum for the JCL in Canon Law (2001-2003). Upon his return to Toulouse, he began teaching canon law at the Studium of the Province and at the Faculty of Canon Law of the Catholic Institute. In 2005, he was called to Rome to work at the Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life, where he remained for eight years. During this period he defended his doctorate in canon law at the Angelicum (2008) and was prior of the Convent of Saints Dominic and Sixtus *in Urbe* (2008-2013). Returning to his province, he was appointed Dean of the Faculty of Canon Law of Toulouse (2013-2016). At the end of 2014, he was elected Prior Provincial of the Province of Toulouse. At the end of his term, the Master of the Order, fr Bruno Cadoré, sent him back to the Angelicum to teach at the Faculty of Canon Law. He became the dean on November 19, 2019 by appointment of the Congregation for Catholic Education. The new rector of the Angelicum, fr Thomas-Joseph White, nominated him to the Master of the Order, fr Gerard Timoner III, to be vice rector. The appointment of the Master of the Order and Grand Chancellor of the University as vice-rector was made on November 4, 2021.
