Student Theology Conference: Call for Papers

The Theology Faculty of the Angelicum invites its students to submit papers for a PUST Student Theological Conference.

- Students currently enrolled in the Theology Faculty in the Second or Third Cycle may submit an abstract of approximately 400-500 words.
- One's current cycle and specialization must be indicated in the submission.
- Only one submission per student is allowed.
- The content of submissions must be theological research.
- Final papers MUST be between 2,500 and 4,000 words (not including footnotes) and follow standard formatting criteria as described in the Theology Methodology Guidelines (available at angelicum.it/theology).
- Submissions must be in a Microsoft Word document.
- Papers written previously for class, or sections of theses, are acceptable to present. It is not necessary to write something new, but an abstract is requested for the submission.
- Only Italian and English language submissions are permitted.
- Submissions are due by <u>January 31, 2024</u>. Those selected for the conference will be notified by February 18.
- Send all submissions to vicedec2@pust.it.
- A small committee working together with Vice Dean Fr. Mariusz Tabaczek, OP will select a maximum of 5 abstracts.
- The titles of papers which will be presented and the names of their authors will be advertised only within the university.
- Presentations will be given the afternoon of March 18.
- The conference is only open to Angelicum students and faculty; one guest for each presenter from outside the university community is allowed to be present. Students presenting a paper must stay for the entirety of the conference.
